

How to measure the area of a triangular garden bed.

1. Measure the base and height of the triangle. (Base is the length of the longest side. Height is the distance from the opposite corner to the base.)
2. Multiply base by height then divide by 2. (This will give the squared measurement.)
3. Then multiply by depth. (Recommended depth is 4 inches or 10 cm)

E.g. $9 \times 5 = 45$

$45 / 2 = 22.5$

$22.5 \times .1(10\text{cm}) = 2.25$
