

1. What is the weight capacity of the bin?

Each bin has a different weight capacity depending on the size bin and type of waste going into the bin. See the table below for more info:

If the weight capacity is exceeded, you will incur extra costs. For more information on these costs see *'What extra charges might apply when hiring a bin?'*. In some circumstances, overloading the weight capacity of the bin means our crane will not physically be able to lift the bin onto our truck. If this is the case, your bin will not be removed until enough waste has been removed to bring it back within the weight allowance. You will incur an extra hire fee per day until the overloaded waste is removed. For more information on extra day charges, see *'What extra charges might apply when hiring a bin?'*

2. What is the volume capacity of the bin?

To ensure we can transport your bin safely, your bin must not be filled above the water line.

If your waste is filled above the water line it will not be picked up and **you will incur an extra hire fee per day** until the overloaded waste is removed. For more information on these costs see *'What extra charges might apply when hiring a bin?'*.



3. What extra charges might apply when hiring a bin?

a. Overweight charges

All bin hire charges have a tipping fee allowance built into the charge. When setting skip bin prices, we do our best to ensure we have allowed customers enough weight capacity to fill the bin without exceeding this limit. These allowances have been based on years of skip bin sales data and have been tailored by waste type. We strongly urge you to read through our 'Weight Guide' before ordering for an indication of what a wheelbarrow of different material might weigh.

If your bin does exceed its weight capacity, you regretfully will also have exceeded the tipping fee allowance of your hire and consequently will incur extra costs. These costs vary depending on the type of waste in your bin:

Waste Type	Tipping Fee
General Waste	\$170.00/tonne
Green Waste	\$66.00/tonne
Oversized Green Waste	\$119.00/tonne
Soil	\$66.00/tonne
Concrete	\$20.00/tonne
Mixed Masonry	\$33.00/tonne

All extra fees will be charged in kilogram increments. For example, if you overload a general waste skip by 100kg (0.1 tonne) you will be charged an extra \$17.00.

b. Extra day charges

If your bin could not be removed due to overloading, overweight or obstruction issues you will incur an extra hire fee per day. This fee will be 10% of your hire **per day**. For example, if you are hiring a 2.5m³ general waste skip and it cannot be removed you will be charged an additional \$32.00 for every day that it is overloaded/overweight/obstructed.

4. Where can the bin be placed?

When selecting the best place to put the bin please refer to the 'Skip Bin Sizes and Measurements' below and ensure there is appropriate access and no overhanging powerlines or tree branches.

If you are ordering a 6m³, 9m³ or 13m³ bin please be aware that the bins are not craned into place but rather lowered and rolled off the truck. **This may cause damage to the surface under the bin. For all skip bin sizes, it is essential for you to consider the risks of unloading, the weight of the bin, the weight of the waste you are placing in the bin and the weight of the truck when choosing the best spot to place the bin. Corkhill Bros cannot accept liability for damaged driveways as a result of the risks outlined above.**

If you wish for your bin to be placed at the rear of your property on government land you must obtain a permit from Access Canberra before placing your order.



5. What are the hire periods?

We offer our bins for 7-day hires **excluding the drop off and pick up day**. As we are unable to specify drop off and pick up times, we have extended our hire to exclude the drop off and pick up days to ensure you receive 7 full days of use of the bin. For example, if you are intending to start work on a Thursday, please arrange for a Wednesday drop off. Unless specified otherwise, this bin will then be booked in for removal the following Thursday. If you wish to hire the bin for a shorter period you can do so, but this will be at the same 7-day hire cost. Please ensure you still allow for the bin to be dropped off the day before you intend to start work.

If you wish to hire the bin for more than 7-days, please contact our team for pricing.

6. When will my bin be dropped off?

Your bin will be dropped off anytime between 7am – 5pm Monday – Friday. Please ensure you leave instructions for the driver for where you wish to have your bin placed.

8. Weight Guide

We understand that it can be difficult to estimate the weight of the material you are putting into your skip bin, and consequently if you are at risk of exceeding the weight limit. To help we have weighed a wheelbarrow of different materials you may put into your skip bin to provide an estimate. **Please note the weights below are to be used as an indication only.**
